MARS TRAINING SHORT BURST MTSB-04

MINIMUM PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENT

THE USAF MARS MINIMUM PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS AS OUTLINED IN THE MARS OPERATING INSTRUCTION (MOI) IS TWELVE HOURS EACH CALENDAR QUARTER WITH AT LEAST SIX OF THESE HOURS EARNED IN YOUR PRIMARY ASSIGNMENT. FOR MOST STATIONS THEIR PRIMARY ASSIGNMENT IS THE AREA TRAFFIC NET.

IT SHOULD NOT BE DIFFICULT TO MEET THE MINIMUM PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENT: MOST DAYS HAVE SCHEDULED FOUR HOURS OF THE AREA TRAFFIC NET. THERE ARE SEVERAL MODES AND NETS IN WHICH ONE MAY ALSO PARTICIPATE. EXAMPLES ARE YOUR STATE VHF NET, YOUR STATE HF NET, THE ECOM NET, TRAINING NETS, ADMINISTRATIVE NET AND TECHNICAL SERVICE NET. IN ADDITION, THERE ARE THE TRANSCON (VOICE AND DIGITAL) AND THE WORLD WIDE SPACE SUPPORT NET. CHECK THE WEB SITE FOR THE CURRENT NET SCHEDULE.

MONTHLY REPORTS

STATIONS ARE ALSO REQUIRED TO PROVIDE A MONTHLY ACTIVITY REPORT TO THEIR SMD. EACH SMD IS FREE TO SPECIFY THE FORMAT AND CONTENT FOR THE MONTHLY REPORT. THE MONTHLY REPORT IS DUE BY THE 10TH OF THE MONTH FOR THE PRECEDING MONTH. CONTACT YOUR SMD FOR INFORMATION.
